

## Movies@Hope COVID-19 Safe Practices

We look forward to seeing you for an in-person Movies@Hope event. Here are our practices for staying as safe as possible:

- A limited number of individual/family outside spaces are available. In-person attendees must make a reservation to claim a spot for the movie. Reservations are first-come, first-served. Email prthomps1 @ verizon.net to reserve a space.
- Please do not attend the movie if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or have been in contact in the last 14 days with anyone who has been diagnosed with the disease.
- **Masks must be worn at all times.** If you leave your mask in the car, please return to get it.
- Bring your own chair, bug spray, and water bottle. Refreshments will not be available, and please **do not bring food**. Hope provides only the movie, the outdoor space, and a restroom if needed.
- At all times, remain **at least six feet apart** from people not in your household, including when entering and exiting. Look for markers on the ground for seating arrangements.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days following the movie, please inform Paul T. immediately so that he may advise everyone else who was at the movie.
- You are responsible for making your best efforts to ensure your safety and the safety of others. Movies@Hope and Hope Lutheran Church assume no responsibility in the event that an attendee contracts COVID-19.
